

SCVA 22nd Annual Las Vegas Classic

Important Schedule Notes:

RE-SEEDING

All teams in the first round that finish 1st, 2nd or 3rd will be re-seeded into the second round by:

1. Pool Finish,
2. Match %,
3. Set %,
4. Point Ratio

All 4th place teams can follow the schedule to see where they play in the second round without waiting for the re-seeding process.

- Due to Reseeding, the live updates posted at www.advancedeventsystems.com will display incorrect logic in the pools in the second round until the reseeding is complete (1st in R1G1P1 (1) will possibly not play in R1G2P1). The live updates should only be used to check scores, not to see where teams advance and play. The official round 2 pools will be posted at Cashman and on the SCVAvolleyball.org web site as soon as possible.

How to Read the schedule:

Every pool is defined by three pieces of information: Round, Group and Pool number. The example below is Round 1, Group 1, Pool 4. The pool will start Friday at 8am on court 89. See “**Play Order**” for the match sequence of the pool. Team 1 is Miz LB 181, team 2 is Skyline 18 RoShamBo, etc...

Ct 89 Fri 8am R1G1P4
Miz LB 181 Skyline 18 RoShamBo SCVC 18-1 SPRI 181

Therefore the winner of this pool can be found in the next round as **1st R1G1P4**, the second place team will be defined as **2nd R1G1P4**, etc...Not all teams play in every round. For example, the 1st R2G2P14 may advance directly to the fourth round. Follow the flowcharts to see where team advance from round to round. Brackets will also have a Round and Group designation but rather than pool, it will have a bracket name. (Example: R3G1 Silver A)

Play Order:

When in pools, teams will follow the play order as shown below. Matches are scheduled on the hour.

Pools of 3
1 vs 3 (2 ref)
2 vs 3 (1 ref)
1 vs 2 (3 ref)

Pools of 4
1 vs 3 (2 ref)
2 vs 4 (1 ref)
1 vs 4 (3 ref)
2 vs 3 (1 ref)
3 vs 4 (2 ref)
1 vs 2 (4 ref)

Pool of 5 on 2 courts	
1 vs 5	2 vs 4 (3 ref)
1 vs 3	2 vs 5 (4 ref)
3 vs 4	1 vs 2 (5 ref)
Break	
3 vs 5	1 vs 4 (2 ref)
2 vs 3	4 vs 5 (1ref)

In pools of 5, teams must ref 2 courts.

One additional R2 will be provided to help

Bracket Ref Assignments:

Ref assignments for brackets are designated by a box around the team name in the bracket. The boxed team must ref the match on their court, one hour before their scheduled match. For all bracket matches, the loser must stay and ref the next match on the court (exceptions: if no match is scheduled or a pool is starting on the court)
